

Kathy's Designer sweatshirt

Supplies:

Sweater that buttons or zips

Long sleeved sweatshirt

1. Cut the sweatshirt open at the center front
2. Cut off the bottom band
3. Cut off the cuffs($\frac{3}{4}$ length is flattering)

Sweater

1. Button the sweater completely
2. Measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " from the center line on both sides from the bottom up to the shoulder
3. Round around the neckline as you would a facing
4. Stitch a straight stitch to stabilize the sweater fabric
5. Cut the sweater using the stitching as your guide line
6. Place the right side of the sweater to the right side of the sweatshirt
7. Pin about every inch to hold the two layers together (all the way around the neck)
8. Cut away the sweatshirt using the sweater as a guide. Leave $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance
9. Cut off the lower band of sweater and apply it over the bottom edge of the sweatshirt
10. Cut off the sleeve bands of the sweater and sew to the bottom of each sleeve
11. Finish with an embroidery design of your choice in a complimentary color You should use Sulky Solvy on a sweatshirt.
